

**Public Meeting
Cornwall, Prince Edward Island**

A public meeting was held at the Cornwall Civic Centre, Cornwall, Prince Edward Island on Wednesday, March 4, 2015, at 7:10 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Minerva McCourt. Mayor McCourt welcomed residents and introduced Deputy Mayor Gary Ramsay, Councillors Jill MacIsaac, Peter Meggs, Shane McGuigan, Chief Administrative Officer Kevin McCarville, Town Planning and Development Officer Dean Lewis and Administrative Assistant, Stephanie Cairns. Regrets were given on behalf of Councillors Dawson and Barnes.

Mayor McCourt called upon Kevin McCarville who noted the purpose of the meeting was to provide the public the opportunity to comment on services provided by the Town and to suggest additional priorities Council should consider in 2015.

The CAO presented the 2015 Budget considerations for the Water & Sewer Utility Corporation and the Town of Cornwall. The CAO reviewed revenue and expenditures for both the Utility Corporation and the Town.

Notice of this meeting was placed in The Guardian on February 28, 2015 and again on March 2, 2015.

There were approximately 13 people in attendance.

The CAO opened the floor to the public at this time.

Allan Manley asked if there is consideration in the budget for enforcement of non-domestic pesticide usage.

The CAO noted the Town is considering this and currently working on a Bylaw if Council decides to move forward.

Allan Manley, resident, inquired into the process of Police Fine Revenue collected.

The CAO explained when a fine/ticket is issued by the police, the Town receives the revenue from the Province once payment is made.

Corey Frizzell, resident, would like to see funds set aside for the Skatepark. Mr. Frizzell inquired if the Town is considering any traffic Safety Measures such as radars. Mr. McCarville noted this has not been considered by the current Council. Mr. Frizzell added he would like to see an electronic event sign in the Town, a booster station on Hilltop Drive and a sidewalk on the Ferry Road.
