# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

## Three ways to register:

### 1. Online registration – recommended method

To register online, you will need to set up your account information and will require a credit card. Please visit <http://cornwallpe.ca/parks-recreation/registration-information/>.

### 2. Phone-in registration

Call 902-628-6260 to register by phone, you will need your credit card and name of classes you want to register for. If you have never registered in any of our programs, you will be required to complete the registration process. We will require medical information including your provincial health card and physician's name and phone number. The initial registration could take up to 10 minutes.

### 3. Walk-in registration

Come prepared to register with the courses or classes you want to register for. You can register for any of the fall programs as of August 26, 2025, by visiting the Town Office at 15 Mercedes Dr.

## PROGRAM CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS

Our best effort is made to provide you with the most accurate information at the time of printing, however schedules are subject to change. We reserve the right to cancel, amend, change, postpone or combine classes/activities that are listed in this guide.

## REFUNDS/ WITHDRAWS

- **Prior to the program start date:** Withdrawals may be made up to **3 days before** a program starts and a full refund will be provided.
- **On or after program start, prior to second class:** Requests received on or after the start date of the program, regardless of class start time, will be pro-rated as of the date of notification and cannot be backdated. Withdrawal/Refund requests may be made no later than one business day prior to the second class. A pro-rated credit for the remaining classes can be left on your account for future program registration use. Refund requests will be pro-rated, as of date of notification and subject to a service fee of \$10.00.
- **After the second class of the program:** Requests made after the second class of the program, will be processed for medical reasons ONLY for the remaining classes of the program and must be accompanied by a doctor's note.

Requests will be processed as of the date of notification and cannot be backdated. Medical requests are not subject to a service charge.

## MISSED CLASSES

In the event a participant is unable to attend a class or for weather cancellation, make-up classes, refunds, or credits for missed classes will not be offered.

## HARMONIZED SALES TAX

# TOWN SPONSORED INITIATIVES

## ACTIVITY CREDIT

The Town of Cornwall values the physical and mental health and wellness of its residents and is committed to developing and investing in strategies that promote participation in recreation, leisure, artistic, educational, and social activities among its residents. The Activity Credit is available to residents who are 17 years or younger or 60 years or older. The credit is in the amount of \$20.00 and available once per fiscal year of April 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026. Residents must present receipt of their activity along with a completed application and confirmation of age and address. Please contact the Town hall (902) 628-6260. for more information on the criteria. Please note: Those who are registered in Cornwall & Area Minor Ball, Eliot River Ramblers, Cornwall & Area Minor Softball, Cornwall Timberwolves, or Lacrosse PEI are not eligible to receive this grant. This is due to the recent decrease in facility rental fees for these organizations.

## APM WALKING SUBSIDY

The Town of Cornwall continues its investment into subsidizing walking track memberships at the APM Centre. This is a great way to continue walking even when the weather gets a little cooler. The Town is offering to pay 100% of a walking track only membership. Simply bring in your receipt from the APM Centre, along with a valid ID confirming that you are a physical resident of Cornwall to the Cornwall Town Hall, and we will gladly reimburse you.

The Town of Cornwall is excited to offer the “Green Lawn Rebate” initiative.

\*The Green Lawn Rebate applies to the rental or purchase of equipment, or a service designed to facilitate natural lawn care maintenance such as an aerator or spreader for lime/organic fertilizer or the provision of a service designed to provide the same. (does not cover product such as grass seed, lime, fertilizer etc)

\*Valid for Cornwall property ONLY (may be owned or rented)

\*The rebate is up to \$50 – one application per Cornwall property per year.

\*Receipt(s) must be attached.

\*Rebate is only applicable for receipts dated May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup> 2025. Applications must be received on or before November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 of the same year of receipt.
