REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Three Ways to Register

1. Online Registration (*Recommended*) - Register online anytime by creating an account and paying with a credit card. Visit: <https://app.univerusrec.com/cornwallpeipub/>

2. Phone Registration - Call **902-628-6260** during office hours (**Monday–Friday, 8:00 a.m.–4:30 p.m.**) to register by phone. Please have your credit card and the names of the programs you wish to register for ready. If you are registering for the first time, we will create your account and collect participant information, including emergency contact details, provincial health card information, and physician contact information. Initial registration may take up to **10 minutes**.

3. In-Person Registration - Register in person at the **Town Office, 15 Mercedes Drive**. Please come prepared with the names of the programs you wish to register for and your preferred method of payment.

Registration for Fall programs opens August 17, 2026.

PROGRAM CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS

Every effort is made to ensure the information in this guide is accurate at the time of publication; however, program details and schedules are subject to change. The Town of Cornwall reserves the right to cancel, postpone, combine, relocate, or modify programs, classes, activities, instructors, dates, times, or locations as necessary.

REFUNDS/ WITHDRAWS

The Town of Cornwall strives to provide high-quality recreation programs while ensuring fair and consistent service to all participants. The following policy applies to all registered recreation programs unless otherwise noted.

- **Before the program starts:** Withdraw up to 5 days before the program start date to receive a full refund.
- **After the program starts (before the second class):** Withdrawal requests must be received no later than one business day before the second class. Requests will be processed from the date of notification and cannot be backdated. Participants may choose:
 - A **pro-rated account credit** for the remaining classes (no service fee), or
 - A **pro-rated refund**, subject to a **\$10.00 service fee**.
- **After the second class:** Refunds will be considered for medical reasons only and must be accompanied by a doctor's note. Refunds will be pro-rated for the remaining classes based on the date of notification and cannot be backdated. No service fee applies to approved medical refunds.
- **Daycamp** – All withdraws from day camps require a 2-week written notice.

MISSED CLASSES

In the event a participant is unable to attend a class or for weather cancellation, make-up classes, refunds, or credits for missed classes will not be offered.

HARMONIZED SALES TAX

HST is 15% and is applicable on programs offered to participants 15 years of age and older. This fee is not included in rates and fees advertised in this brochure.

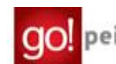
