RESOLVED:

Whereas: The Town of Cornwall Water and Sewer Utility requires a rate study to ensure that the rates and rate structure for the water and sewer utility are adequate to provide high quality service, and to ensure the ongoing financial stability and viability of the system, and to ensure the costs of operating and maintaining the system are allocated equitably among the various classes of user,

And Whereas: The Town has previously applied for fifty percent (\$16,500) of the required funds for this project through the Municipal Strategic Component of the Gas Tax program,

And Whereas: The application for the Municipal Strategic Component funding was not approved, but the Direct Allocation (CIP) portion of the Gas Tax fund was approved,

Therefore, Be it Resolved: That the Town of Cornwall increase the funds for this approved project from the Direct Allocation (CIP) program to \$33,000 to cover the entire cost of the project.
