1. Online registration – recommended method

To register online, you will need to set up your account information and will require a credit card. Please visit www.cornwallpe.ca to register online. Online registration begins **December 19, 2024, at 8:30 a.m.** After that, you can register online anytime.

2. Phone-in registration

Call 902-628-6260, option "0". To register by phone, you will need your credit card and the name of classes you want to register for. If you have never registered in any of our programs, you will be required to complete the registration process. We will require medical information including your provincial health card and physician's name and phone number. The initial registration could take up to 10 minutes.

COMMUNITY GRANTS / SUBSIDIES

ACTIVITY CREDIT

The Town of Cornwall values the physical and mental health and wellness of its residents and are committed to developing and investing in strategies that promote participation in recreation, leisure, artistic, educational, and social activities among its residents. The new Activity Credit is available to residents who are 17 years or younger or 60 years or older. The credit is in the amount of \$ 20.00 and available **once** per fiscal year of April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025.

Residents must present receipt of their activity along with a completed application and confirmation of age and address. Please contact the Town hall (902) 628-6260. for more information on the criteria. All applications for the Activity Credit must be returned to Town Hall no later than March 31st to be approved for the 2024/25 year.

Please note: Those who are registered in Cornwall & Area Minor Ball, Eliot River Ramblers, Cornwall & Area Minor Softball, Cornwall Timberwolves, or Lacrosse PEI are not eligible to receive this grant. This is due to the recent decrease in facility rental fees for these organizations.

SPORT TOURISM GRANT

The Town of Cornwall is committed to developing and investing in strategies that promote economic development and recreation and tourism in our community. With some of the first-class recreational facilities in our Province the Town wants to expand the opportunity in utilizing these facilities to host Provincial, Atlantic, and National competitions.
