DELEGATIONS/PUBLIC INPUT

Adrian Desbarats president of the Eliot River Ramblers Association presented to Council an update on the association numbers, field usage, player fees and the club's plan for the future. The Ramblers would like to work with the Town short and long term to continue to grow the club and raised the possibility of field rental fee reductions. Mr. Desbarats suggested, among other things, that the club pay 25% of the turf field maintenance costs. Councillor Frizzell suggested the possibility of the Ramblers leasing the facility.

PARKS & RECREATION

a) Reports

- i) Monthly Report – Updated report added in package. Summer Camp has been great, and inspections have gone well. Staff continue to assess the children each day upon arrival. Although taking temperatures is no longer necessary, staff continue to do it as part of the daily procedure.

b) Items for Discussion

- I. Youth Centre Reopening – Will discuss at September’s meeting.
- II. Building/Facility Rentals – There have been requests for facility bookings now that COVID restrictions have been lifted somewhat. It was the direction that staff could look at rentals as long as all the Town needs are given priority and met first.
- III. Fall Programs – After School Camp will be starting back up with COVID restrictions. Staff are awaiting final directives from CPHO on other fall programs.
- IV. Cornfest – Council agreed to have staff move forward with a scaled back version of Cornfest as long as events follow CPHO guidelines.
- V. Disc Golf – The disc golf course has been moved to the Terry Fox Sports Complex. There will be a tournament in September and another as part of Cornfest.
- VI. Main Street Trail Lighting - The engineers are looking at different lighting options for the trail.
