Whereas: The Town of Cornwall has received resident inquiries regarding the potential of having school crossing guards from time to time and particularly so this school year, primarily at Westwood Elementary School, but at other locations as well,

And Whereas: The Town of Cornwall has in the past provided school crossing guard services and is in favour of providing the service again if it is shown to be necessary,

Therefore, be it Resolved: That the Town of Cornwall hire and train (through the City of Charlottetown) two crossing guards as a pilot project with the project to be evaluated prior to the passing of the 2021-2020 operating budget,

And, be it Further Resolved: That one crossing guard be positioned at Westwood Elementary School, the second to serve as a backup to the Westwood position or as may be further determined by council.
