**DELEGATIONS/PUBLIC INPUT**

- Coastal Protection Sunrise Cove: Sunrise Cove residents Geoff Boyle, Rob MacAdam and Brody Carter presented to Council to consider a natural park with a functional recreation space and shore access with particular attention paid to preventing further erosion. Currently there is limited shore access due to overgrown trees. There was discussion with Council on possible options for the area. The gentlemen thanked Council for their time.

**PARKS & RECREATION**

- a) Monthly Report – Included in package
  - Snowfest: People are not yet used to having to pre-register for events so will be an adjustment. Deputy Mayor Stevenson suggested do a “last call” each

day to remind people to register. Staff will be handing out treat bags to families at the Outdoor Family Fun event and Town branded items will be given as prizes at various events. Event info was sent to Community Connectors in an effort to reach new residents.

- Mayor McCourt asked if people were using the Town trails for walking. Staff advised that trails, especially at the Terry Fox Complex get a lot of usage.
  - Issues with hockey players have decreased now that the rinks at the Terry Fox Complex are open and there is staff overseeing the Town Hall rink in the evenings.
- b) Tree Proposal – There was further discussion on a proposal from Bill Hogg and June Sanderson regarding tree planting and rural beautification for the Town. CAO Coady suggested that staff and Council should come up with a proposal that would allow residents to get Town owned trees to replant at their own expense.
- c) Sports Tourism Strategy – It was moved by Councillor Barnes and seconded by Councillor MacIsaac to bring forth a resolution that the Town of Cornwall will adopt a Sport Tourism Strategy Policy on a one-year pilot project for event hosting as a means of increasing tourism in the Town.
- d) Fencing Town Hall Playground – The Town received a request to have a fence erected around the new playground at Town Hall. There was discussion on other possible solutions that would help alleviate the risk of children running towards the road.
