### COSMETIC PESTICIDE BYLAW - INFESTATION EXCEPTION NOTIFICATION

Pursuant to Section 7.1 of the Town of Cornwall Cosmetic Pesticide Bylaw, a Certified Applicator may apply a Non-Domestic Pesticide that is not included in Appendix A, Allowable Pesticides of this Bylaw but that is permitted by the Province of Prince Edward Island for the following purposes or activities:

- a) to destroy, Prevent or control a species of plant that is poisonous to human by touch;
- b) to destroy, prevent or control an alien invasive plant species that may negatively affect the health of humans, the environment or the economy;
- c) in a scientific experiment or for research purposes; or
- d) to trat an insect infestation where the number of insects exceed the threshold level specified in Appendix B of the Bylaw: Insect Infestation Thresholds.

An Applicator must conduct an infestation threshold test in accordance with the methodology stipulated in Appendix B of the Bylaw and submit this notification form signed by the Applicator. Notification forms may be submitted to the Town at 15 Mercedes Drive or via email to town@cornwallpe.ca.

- flotation method greater than 200 per 0.1 m<sup>2</sup>; or Quadrat method - greater than 20 per 0.1 m<sup>2</sup>
- White Grubs - greater then 5 per 0.1 m<sup>2</sup>
- Sod Webworms - greater than 10 per 0.9 m<sup>2</sup>
- European Crane Fly (*tipula pludosa*) - greater than 25 per 0.9 m<sup>2</sup>
