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COMMUNITY INFORMATION

PLANNING

Did you know most projects on your property require a Development Permit before the project can be started? Here is what you should know:

What is a Development Permit? It is official permission from the Town that allows you to start certain types of work or make changes on your property. It ensures that your project follows the local rules and regulations for safety, zoning, and proper land use. Permits help protect you, your neighbours, and the community by making sure work is done right.

When do you need a Development Permit? A permit is required for most construction, additions, and outdoor projects, even small ones. This includes but is not limited to building or altering a deck, putting up a fence taller than 4 feet, sheds, installing a swimming pool, constructing or changing the use of any building or structure, and doing any underground work like septic tanks, sewer connections, or foundation walls. You also need a permit to construct a driveway, dump fill or gravel, or move or demolish a structure. It's always best to check first, so please reach out to the Planning Department as they will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Are there any projects people often forget need a Development Permit? People often don't realize you need a permit for temporary structures like tarp buildings or portable garages, installing solar panels and signage. Pools especially are overlooked, but they must be fenced with a 6-foot barrier that prevents access.

What happens if I start without a Development Permit? Starting work without a permit can lead to fines, and your permit fee will double. In some cases, you may be ordered to undo or remove the work.

Is one Permit enough? In some cases, no. You'll need a Development Permit from the Town and a Building Permit from the Province. The Town permit ensures the project meets local bylaws, while the provincial permit ensures it follows the National Building Code of Canada. If you're unsure, we can help.

How do I apply for a Development Permit and what is the process to receive it? Applications are available at Town Hall or online at <https://cornwallpe.ca/departments/planning-and-development/>. When in doubt, give us a shout!

LAWN CARE REBATE PROGRAM

The Green Lawn Rebate applies to the rental or purchase of equipment, or a service designed to facilitate natural lawn care maintenance such as an aerator or spreader for lime/organic fertilizer, or the provision of a service designed to provide the same.

* Valid for Cornwall property ONLY (may be owned or rented)

*The rebate is up to \$50 – one application per Cornwall property per year

*Receipt(s) must be attached

*Can be claimed if you hire a company to do services such as aerating/fertilizing

Rebate is only applicable for receipts dated May 1st to October 1st, 2026. Applications must be received on or before November 30, 2026

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Three ways to register:

1. Online registration – recommended method

To register online, you will need to set up your account information and will require a credit card. Please visit www.cornwallpe.ca. Online registration begins **May 14th, 2026, at 8:30am**

2. Phone-in registration

Call 902- 628 - 6260 to register by phone, you will need your credit card and name of classes you want to register for. If you have never registered in any of our programs, you will be required to complete the registration process. We will require medical information including your provincial health card and physician's name and phone number. The initial registration could take up to 10 minutes. **Office Hours: Monday to Friday - 8:00am - 4:00pm**

3. Walk-in registration – (If you have no other options)

Come prepared to register with the courses or classes you want to register for. You can register for any of the summer programs as of May 14th, 2026, by visiting Town Office at 15 Mercedes Dr.

PROGRAM CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS

Our best effort is made to provide you with the most accurate information at the time of printing; however, schedules are subject to change. We reserve the right to cancel, amend, change, postpone or combine classes/activities that are listed in this guide.

REFUNDS / WITHDRAWALS

- **Prior to the program start date:** Withdrawals may be made up to **48 hours before** a program starts, a full refund will be applied. If cancellation is within 48 hours of the start date of the program a service fee of \$ 10.00 will be applied.
- **On or after program start, prior to second class:** Requests received on or after the start date of the program, regardless of class start time, will be pro-rated as of the date of notification and cannot be backdated. Withdrawal/Refund requests may be made no later than one business day prior to the second class. A pro-rated credit for the remaining classes can be left on your account for future program registration use. Refund requests will be pro-rated, as of date of notification and subject to a service fee of \$10.
- **After the second class of the program:** Requests made after the day of the second class of the program, will be processed for medical reasons ONLY for the remaining classes of the program and must be accompanied by a doctor's note.
- **All camp refunds require a two-week written notice.**
- Requests will be processed as of the date of notification and cannot be backdated. Medical requests are not subject to a service charge.

MISSED CLASSES

In the event a participant is unable to attend a class or for weather cancellation, make-up classes, refunds, or credits for missed classes will not be offered.

HARMONIZED SALES TAX

HST is now 15 % and is applicable on programs offered to participants 15 years of age and older.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

The Preschool Program gives children a head start on learning to swim. Preschool Programs develop an appreciation and healthy respect for the water before these kids get in too deep. In our preschool progressions, we work to ensure 3 to 5yr old become comfortable in the water and have fun developing a foundation of water skills. We incorporate Lifesaving Society Water Smart® education in all preschool levels.

PRESCHOOL 1

These preschoolers learn to get in and out of the water safely. They will learn to move safely in shallow water and use a lifejacket to be comfortable with their floats and glides.

PRESCHOOL 2

These youngsters will explore the water learning to submerge and exhale underwater. Buoyant aids are used to help them discover rollovers, glides, and flutter kicks.

PRESCHOOL 3

These preschoolers will master their floats, glides, and short swims on their front and back (2-3 m). They will be able to pick up objects from the waist deep water and use their lifejackets to jump and roll into the deep end.

PRESCHOOL 4

These capable preschoolers will strengthen their flutter kicks and try swimming front crawl. They will start to learn how to support themselves in deep water and in the end, they will do solo jumps and side rolls into deep water. Their lifejacket will support them while they learn to tread water and swim to safety (5-10m) in the deep end.

SWIMMER PROGRAMS

The Swimmer program makes sure children learn how to swim before they get in too deep. Progressions accommodate 5 to 12-year old's including beginners and swimmers who want to build on the basics. Lots of in-water practice develops solid swimming strokes and skills. Water Smart® education is part of every level.

SWIMMER 1

These beginning swimmers will work on safe entries, exits and moving through the water. When ready they will do floats, glides and kicking on their front and back without assistance. They will even explore jumping into deep water and treading water with their lifejackets on.

SWIMMER 2

These children will be able to jump or side roll into deep water, tread water, and swim (10-15 m) using either front crawl or back crawl. They will try 'vertical' whip kick and begin to work on their endurance level by stepping into the world of fitness interval training.

SWIMMER 3

These swimmers will dive and do forward rolls into deep water. Watch them learn handstands and front somersaults underwater. They will work on their front crawl, back crawl and whip kick over short distances and add some interval fitness training to their practice. By the end they will be able to meet the Swim to Survive standard: Roll into deep water, tread water (1 min.) and swim (50 m).

SWIMMER 4

These swimmers will swim further with their front crawl and back crawl. They will get introduced to breaststroke arms drills, underwater swims, and front crawl sprints. Interval training will add to their fitness level.

SWIMMER 5

These swimmers will try eggbeater kick, head up front crawl, and shallow dives. And just for fun try 'tuck' jumps and underwater back somersaults. They will easily go the distance with a strong front crawl, back crawl, and breaststroke.

SWIMMER 6

These swimmers will master eggbeater and scissor kicks, front crawl, breaststroke, and back crawl. With the interval training and sprint racing drills they will be ready to make the 300 m endurance workout. And just for fun they will try stride jumps and compact jumps. Next step: on to the Canadian Swim Patrol program
